TRAINING OVERVIEW

The San Diego Prevention Research Center (SDPRC), a five-year project funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, is conducting a conference for selected health agencies, community organizations, and schools that work with the Latino Community. The conference is aimed at increasing the health and well-being of Latinos through physical activity and healthy eating habits

Since last year's conference reached maximum capacity, it is important that your team follow the instructions listed under "Registration Process."

WHAT YOU WILL RECEIVE

There is no charge to attend the training. The SDPRC will provide participants with the following:

- Lunch on both days

THE TEAM CONCEPT

Invited agencies, organizations, and schools are being asked to assemble a team of staff members (at least 3) who will work together to advocate and promote physical activity programs for the Latino Community. We recommend comprising a team of administrators, health educators, promotoras (es), nurses, program managers and coordinators, and social workers from your agency. Your team will be asked to complete a pre-conference activity together.

FEATURING DR. AMELIE RAMIREZ

Dr. Ramirez is Professor of Epidemiology and Biostatistics at The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio (UTHSCSA). She is also Director of the new Institute for Health Promotion Research at the UTHSCSA and the Cancer Therapy and Research Center (CTRC) in San Antonio.

Over the past 25 years, Dr. Ramirez has directed numerous state-, federal- and privately funded research programs focusing on human and organizational communication to reduce chronic disease and cancer health disparities affecting Hispanics/Latinos and other populations.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Since last year's conference reached maximum capacity, it is important that your team follow these instructions:

1. Assign one member of your team to be the designated team leader
2. Team leader submits team form identifying all team members
3. Team leader will then receive confirmation letter, team registration forms, and team activity form by April 2007 for all team members
4. Team leader submits team registration forms and team activity form by May 1, 2007.
